Re: Cell Phones and PDA's in Changerooms



The use cellular phone and personal digital assistants (PDA) in changing rooms has become a potential risk.

In growing numbers, these digital devices are being manufactured with cameras that allow photographs to be taken and shared electronically. The potential exists for photographs to be taken without permission during regular hockey activities like changing and/or showering.



The Ontario Recreation Facilities Association (ORFA) has issued a Facility Alert.

"O.R.F.A. President, Dan McArthur recommends that signage be posted immediately that "Prohibits the use of cell phones, and personal digital assistants in all recreation facility change rooms"."



The OHF acknowledges the recommendation of ORFA and directs all members to govern themselves accordingly.
